VESS Early Career Faculty Research Award 2015

One \$12,500 grant for basic science or clinical research will be awarded during the VESS spring meeting on Wednesday, June 17, 2015 in Chicago, IL. The application deadline is Friday, May 1, 2015.

Eligible candidates must identify as an early career faculty member. "Early career" implies holding a full-time vascular surgery academic appointment within five (5) years of completing surgical training at the time of grant submission. Senior vascular surgery trainees (2nd year fellows or 5th year residents) are eligible with proof of appointment at an academic medical center upon graduation. The applicant must be a VESS member in good standing.

APPLICATION COMPONENTS (15 pages total, inclusive of all items below):

- 1. Introductory letter (<1 page)*
- 2. Letter of support and oversight from vascular surgery division chief (<1 page)**
- 3. NIH bio-sketch for PI (NIH format, 3 pages)
- 4. Other support (NIH format)
- 5. Title and abstract (<200 words)
- 6. Grant proposal (7 pages)***
 - a. Specific aim (1 page)
 - b. Background (1 page)
 - c. Preliminary data (1 page)
 - d. Project (4 pages)
 - e. Literature citation list (exempt from page limit)
- 7. Budget with justification (1 page)****

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- 1. Page Margins: Layout and format should conform to current NIH standards
- 2. A summary report is expected to be presented at the VESS spring meeting during the SVS Vascular Annual Meeting in 2016.
